this user guide has been developed to consolidate existing imo maritime security related material into an easily read companion guide to solas chapter xi 2 and the isps code in order to assist states in promoting maritime security through development of the requisite legal framework associated administrative practices procedures and the necessary material technical and human resources it includes the international ship and port facility security code isps code

this code of practice developed jointly by the international labour office and the international maritime organization contains a guidance framework for the formulation and implementation of security strategies and the identification of potential security risks aimed at governments employers and workers it is intended to promote a common approach to port security amongst member states the guidelines deal with a variety of issues including security roles tasks and measures to deter detect and respond to unlawful acts against ports serving international traffic and maritime operations as well as considering security awareness and training practical examples of a port security assessment and a port security plan are also included this code follows where possible the practice and principles identified in the imo s isps code and acts as a valuable complementary guidance document to it by extending consideration of port security beyond the area of the port facility into the whole port

managing the ever changing nature and cross disciplinary challenges of the maritime sector demands a complete understanding of the special characteristics of the maritime space the complexity of the operations of ships ports shipping companies and naval and

coast guard maritime security operations as well as the economic significance and the in over recent decades it has been widely recognised that terrorist attacks at sea could result in major casualties and cause significant disruptions to the free flow of international shipping after discussing the overlaps and distinctions between piracy and maritime terrorism this book considers how the international ship and port facility security code and other vessel identification and tracking measures in the 1974 international convention for the safety of life at sea would be likely to reduce the risk of terrorist attacks at sea it explains how the 1982 united nations convention on the law of the sea is less than clear on the powers of states to protect offshore installations submarine cables and pipelines from interference by terrorists in light of these uncertainties it considers how the 2005 protocol to the convention for the suppression of unlawful acts against maritime navigation the doctrine of necessity and states inherent self defence rights might apply in the maritime security context a significant contribution of the book is the formulation of the maritime terrorism threat matrix which provides a structured framework for examining how maritime terrorism incidents have occurred and might occur in the future the book also examines the relevant national maritime security legislation for preventing maritime terrorist attacks in the united kingdom and in australia the book concludes by formulating guidelines for the unilateral interdiction of suspected terrorist vessels in exceptional circumstances and recommending priorities for governments and international maritime industries to focus on in order to reduce the risk for terrorist attacks at sea it will be of interest to those working in the areas of law and terrorism law of the sea maritime law and insurance and international law

drawing on the essential premises of the law of the sea convention as constotuion of the oceans this book looks into the ways it can be evolved to accommodate new challenges to its regulatory scheme
